Do Elephants Dream of Eclectic Sheep? takes some inspiration from The Velveteen Rabbit and Philip K. Dick's Do Androids Dream of Electric Sheep? In each, the characters maintain hope, empathy, and look to connect to something that's "real", even in bleak circumstances.
